The Headliners Foundation, associated with the Headliners Club in Austin, has been awarding scholarships to outstanding students interested in journalism for close to thirty years. In awarding the scholarships, the Foundation considers first of all the talent for and the commitment to journalism as demonstrated in an application essay and the applicant's involvement with journalism either professionally or on campus. The Foundation also considers grades and the recommendations of teachers or professional journalists. Financial need is taken into consideration only when all other qualities are considered equal. Past scholarship recipients include reporters, producers, authors, photographers and journalists around the country. 1. The Headliners Foundation may award as many as 6 scholarships valued up to \$6,000 per school year (\$3,000 each semester) from the following universities:
 - a. Abilene Christian University
 - b. Baylor University
 - c. Sam Houston State University
 - d. Southwestern University
 - e. St. Edward's University
 - f. Stephen F. Austin State University
 - g. Texas A&M University
 - h. Texas Christian University
 - i. Texas State University
 - j. Texas Tech University
 - k. University of Houston
 - l. University of North Texas
 - m. University of Texas at Austin
2. The Sam Wood Scholarship (\$3,000 per year) is awarded to a Baylor student in memory of the former editor of the *Austin American-Statesman*.
3. The Jack Keever Scholarship is awarded to the managing editor of the *Daily Texan* at UT Austin each semester. The summer scholarship is valued at \$250 and each semester scholarship is valued at \$500. The managing editor of the *Daily Texan* may also apply for and receive a Headliners Foundation scholarship as listed above.
4. The Texas Associated Press Broadcasters Scholarship, valued at \$1,000 per school year, will be awarded to a qualified broadcast student from one of the schools listed in section 1.
